This effort aims to build on existing strategic partnerships and open new opportunities aligned with the visions of the two countries' leadership.

During his official visit to Oman, HE Minister Fakhro met with Omani Minister of Commerce, Industry and Investment Promotion, HE Qais bin Mohammed Al Yousef. The discussions focused on enhancing bilateral trade, investment, and economic diversification efforts.



The visit also included meetings with HE Sultan bin Salim Al Habsi, Omani Minister of Finance, and other key officials and business leaders. Opportunities for cooperation in priority sectors and between private sector stakeholders were highlighted, along with discussions on high-value investments.

His Excellency Mr. Abdulla4+5 bin Adel Fakhro, Minister of Industry and Commerce, led Bahrain's delegation to the Invest Kerala Global Summit in Kochi, India. The event, organized by Kerala's Industrial Development Corporation, brought together global investors and officials.

In his keynote, the Minister highlighted the strong historical ties between Bahrain and India and expressed Bahrain's commitment to these relations to boost innovation deepening entrepreneurship. He emphasized Bahrain's strategic location as a gateway to Middle Eastern and global markets, supported by investor-friendly policies such as 100% foreign ownership and simplified business procedures.

The Minister showcased Bahrain's promising sectors including advanced manufacturing, fintech, sustainable energy, and downstream industries aligned with Bahrain Economic Vision 2030. He invited Kerala's entrepreneurs to explore Bahrain's well-equipped industrial zones and free trade agreements.

He also identified key cooperation areas: technology and digitization, manufacturing, food security and agriculture, and tourism. Bahrain aims to enhance collaboration by removing trade barriers and simplifying processes.

During the summit, the Minister met with Kerala's Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan, India's Commerce Minister Piyush Goyal, Kerala's Industry Minister P. Rajeeve, and Lulu Group's Chairman Yusuff Ali.

The summit aims to attract investment in key sectors like tourism, fintech, health innovation, and sustainable industries, fostering long-term partnerships.







World Intellectual Property Day 2025




The Foreign Trade and Industrial Property Directorate at the Ministry of Industry and Commerce organized the celebration of World Intellectual Property Day 2025, where HE Ms. Eman Ahmed Al Doseri honored a number of distinguished intellectual property rights holders in the Kingdom of Bahrain, to encourage highlighting intellectual property rights and emphasize their active role in supporting innovation and creativity in the Kingdom. This supports the objectives of World Intellectual Property Day to enable knowledge economy and promote innovation culture.









Trade Names



Trade names are considered one of the fundamental pillars of conducting economic and commercial activities. They serve as the tool for distinguishing shops and commercial establishments from one another in the market. A trade name holds great importance as it represents the identity of a business and influences consumer perception and trust.

With the development of economic activity and the expansion of markets, the need arose to regulate the use of trade names through laws and legislation that ensure the rights of their owners and prevent deception or infringement. In this context, Law No. (18) of 2012 concerning Trade Names was enacted to provide a clear legal framework for selecting, registering, and using trade names. The law aims to ensure fairness, legitimate competition, and the protection of consumers from fraud and deception.

Regulating trade names also contributes to attracting investments and enhancing investor confidence in the economic environment by providing legal protection for the names and trademarks used to build business reputations. Moreover, it is an important means of protecting intellectual property and preventing commercial disputes related to similarities or violations of others' rights.

Law No. (18) of 2012 on trade names comes as part of the state's efforts to regulate the commercial environment in a way that balances protecting the rights of trade name owners and encouraging investment and competitiveness in the market.

First: Objectives of the Law

Create a regulated competitive environment.

Protect intellectual property rights related to trade names.

Encourage local and foreign investment.

Prevent infringement or harmful similarities between trade names.

Ensure transparency and clarity in market transactions.

Second: Key Provisions of the Law

Definition of a Trade Name:

A trade name is the name used by a merchant or business to distinguish its commercial activity from others.

Registration of the Trade Name:

It is mandatory to register the trade name in the commercial registry. A trade name cannot be registered if it is identical or similar to a previously registered name, unless with the consent of the existing owner or if there is sufficient distinction between them.

Protection of the Trade Name:

The law grants ownership and legal protection to the registered name. Infringement or imitation of a trade name is considered a legal violation subject to penalty.

Transfer and Assignment of a Trade Name:

A trade name may be transferred or assigned to another party according to specific procedures and within defined regulations.

Cancellation of a Trade Name:

A trade name may be removed from the registry if it has not been used for a certain period or if it violates applicable laws and regulations.

Third: Penalties

Article (23):

Anyone who uses a trade name owned by another person or uses it in a way that misleads the public, shall be fined between 500 to 1,000 BDs.
